FLUSHING OPERATIONS:

Commencing this evening (Sunday, September 5, 2021) the City of Flat Rock will be flushing sanitary sewers in the Hickory Ridge subdivision. This flushing effort may cause your drinking water to become discolored. If this occurs, please turn on all faucets and allow water to run until it clears.

The effort is to flush the sanitary sewers in the area of concern.

Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation as the city continues work to stabilize the situation.

RIVERFEST:

Due to the ongoing efforts on the gasoline spill, Flat Rock Riverfest will be cancelled. All events for September 10th & 11th have been cancelled.
