Good Evening Flat Rock Families,

For those of you that attended the Town Hall this evening there were some technical issues and I was not able to speak with you live. Please know that there was no intent on anyone's part, just a result of many moving parts and trying to work with a very short timeline.

Flat Rock Community Schools will continue to assist and partner with the City of Flat Rock in any way necessary in order to support our school families and our community as a whole. It is times like these that we all must band together for the greater good. We have amazing human resources working this problem, and I am confident that these individuals will work this issue to an acceptable solution.

A point of clarification. All five school buildings were tested today and all five buildings had zero findings. We will continue to work with and be advised by the EPA, the City of Flat Rock and any other governmental agency that is supporting the community of Flat Rock right now.

None of our Flat Rock Community Schools buildings are in the incident zones, and because all buildings have been tested and will continue to be monitored by the EPA, all **Flat Rock Community Schools will be open for in-person learning on Tuesday, September 7, 2021**. I know this may be a challenge for some of our residents and their children, but providing a safe haven and some normalcy has the potential to have an incredibly positive impact on the students.

As many others have said over the past few days, this is a very fluid situation. If changes or modifications need to be made to our school schedule we will communicate that information in as timely a manner as possible.
